## **Candidates requirements**

- → The students have obtained their diploma (Engineer, Master Degree or MBA) from a RMEIM member institutions during the Academic year 2020/2021.
- → The Students' work should be in line with one of the UNESCO Sustainable Development Goals.

## How to apply

- → Application deadline: 15th February, 2022
- → Uploaded Europass CV (in English)
- ➔ An abstract of the final year Project / Master Thesis. English language is mandatory, with a maximum of 3000 characters (spaces not included). The abstract must include: title, affiliation, bibliography and one figure max (if needed). PDF format is required.
- → Master Thesis or Final Report. PDF format is required.

Applicants will receive an acknowledgment of receipt. Incomplete applications will not be processed for evaluation.

Applications will be evaluated by experts appointed by Prof Abdelmajid JEMNI from Monastir University (TN), President of the RMEI-M Prize Committee. The winner will be invited to present his/her Master Thesis or Final Project during a special dedicated session during the RMEIM General Assembly 2022, at Sousse-Monastir, TUNISIA: 17-19 March, 2022.
