REQUIREMENTS AND BENEFITS

- Participants must be Spanish citizens and permanent residents in Catalonia , engineering or science graduates from universities in Catalonia (or other European universities and residents of Catalonia), speak and write fluently in both Catalan and Spanish, and be able to succeed in courses taught in English.
- Applicants must be accepted for graduate study at UCI, UCD, UCB, or UCCS and then apply for the Balsells Fellowship. Each fellow pursues an MS degree, with an option to continue for a PhD degree.
- Balsells fellows receive a competitive monthly stipend, as well as payment of tuition, fees, and a portion of health insurance a combined value of more than US \$50,000 per year.

Fellowships are cosponsored by the Generalitat de Catalunya, Balsells Foundation and universities.
